November 2022 Trails Updates

The fall season is a great time to take advantage of the trails system and this year continues to be particularly favourable for outdoor activities.

Activity Trails Maps are available throughout the Resort Village of Candle Lake at local businesses and on the Resort Village website, along with maps for cross-country skiing and snowshoeing. Trail Head maps will be updated over the next few months.



Exciting Trails Announcements from the Resort Village

- The tender to extend the West Side Trail from Bereskin Drive to Main Street has been approved and construction should begin soon. Weather permitting, this work should be complete this fall.
- A walking path from Simon Lehne to the Mini Golf will be developed to extend both the Simon Lehne Trail and the Main Street Trail and provide safer pedestrian access to this popular spot.
- Subject to funding approval, Resort Village Council has approved a development plan to build a trail from the Bayview commercial area to connect to the Recreation area and Bay Lake Trails.

Remember...

To ensure the safety of everyone, cyclists are reminded to announce their presence when approaching pedestrians on the trails. Motorized vehicles such as ATVs and snowmobiles are not allowed on the West Side Trail, or any pedestrian pathway. These vehicles create ruts and erode the crusher dust surface that we all love to walk on year-round. Every effort will be made to keep the West Side Trail in good walking condition throughout the winter, but sometimes a little patience may be required.

55+ Housing Open House Update

The RVCL Sustainability Planning process has identified a need for housing that supports residents as they transition from early retirement to a stage of life where housing maintenance becomes an issue. The average age of Candle Lake full time residents is 56 years old. Currently we see long-time residents move away when their life circumstances change. A Housing Information Meeting was held on October 24th to discuss changing housing needs and options to meet the needs of our community. Thank you to the almost 100 local residents that attended the meeting to provide input and share their ideas. The public is encouraged to complete and submit the public survey that was handed out at the meeting to the Resort Village Office or complete it online at www.candlelake. ca under LATEST NOTICES. Additional paper copies of the survey are available at the Office as well.

Water and Wastewater

As you know, the Water Security Agency regulates the operation of our Water Works and Sewage Lagoons in the Resort Village. In September, compliance inspections were completed at our water and wastewater facilities, and the Environmental Protection Officer issued Compliance Reports. No issues were identified at either of our lagoons. As a result of our ongoing efforts to responsibly manage our lagoons, the Resort Village is able to permit septic haulers to once again haul liquid waste to the East Lagoon. Based on the current available capacity at the East Lagoon, we are hopeful it will not be necessary to reinstate restrictions in the future. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work to enhance and maintain our community infrastructure!
