RESORT VILLAGE OF CANDLE LAKE BYLAW NO. 09-2023

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF CANDLE LAKE to revise and update the fees payable to the Resort Village of Candle Lake for municipal services rendered under the authority of The Municipalities Act, The Planning and Development Act 2007, and the Bylaws of the Resort Village.

WHEREAS the Council of the Resort Village of Candle Lake deems it advisable to include in one By-law the fees and charges payable to the Resort Village for certain services rendered by officers and employees of the Resort Village;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF CANDLE LAKE IN OPEN SESSION ASSEMBLED HEREBY ENACTS AS A BY-LAW AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT this By-law shall be known as THE FEES AND CHARGES BYLAW;
- 2. THAT the fees and charges payable to the Resort Village of Candle Lake for services rendered by officers and employees of the Resort Village shall be as set out in the following schedules attached hereto;

Schedule "D"	Environmental Health Services

Schedule "F"	Building Permits
Schedule "G"	Parks and Recreation Services

- 3. THAT Council may from time to time, by resolution at any regular or special meeting of Council, amend each and every schedule attached to this By-law;
- 4. THAT the fees and charges set out in the schedules attached to this By-law shall take precedence over any other By-law or policy.
- 5. THAT all fees related to building inspections are approved as set by the Building Inspector or Building Inspection Company contracted by the Resort Village to provide Building Inspection Services.
- 6. THAT wherever allowed for within the Municipalities Act, any unpaid fees or charges owed to the Resort Village by any taxpayer including any penalties related thereto as well as any fines imposed on the taxpayer by the court for contravention of the Resort Village By-laws may be added to the taxes of

the said taxpayer and may be collected or enforced in the same manner as a tax as defined by the Municipalities Act.

Repeal:

- 7. That Bylaw 01-2023 is hereby repealed.
- 8. THAT this By-law shall come into force and effect on May 18, 2023.
