Congratulations to Jodi Brown, our July Bingo Loonie Pot Winner. With Jodi is Faye McKay, Vice-Chair, SCR Board.







- · E-transfer to info@candlelake.ca
- · TIPPS (Tax Installment Payment Plan Service Program) - TIPPS offers equalized monthly property tax payments. To sign up for TIPPS, withdraw from TIPPS, or change your banking information for TIPPS, please contact the Resort Village at (306) 929-2236 or info@candlelake.ca.
- · Print and complete the Preauthorized Debit Form to make recurring payments from your account. Return the completed form to the Resort Village Office by scanning and emailing it to info@candlelake.ca, or by dropping off a copy.

## **Council Meeting Highlights**

#### **JUNE**

Lagoon Waste Management Rate - Council approved a Bylaw establishing the annual rate of \$100 per property for the operation of the Lagoons subject to final approval by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board.

Property Maintenance & Nuisance Abatement Bylaw - Council amended the Bylaw to include reference to the Fire Safety Act and the Municipalities Act. This will enhance enforcement efforts when dealing with noncompliant properties.

55 Plus Seniors Housing Initiative - Council amended the Memorandum of Understanding with Zaks Building Group and Claystone Development extending the term to August 31, 2025, to provide more time to negotiate terms for a land sale agreement.

Campground Development - Council approved conditions for the development of up to 30 campsites within the Misty Meadows RV Park previously approved under an agreement between the Village and the Misty Meadows RV Park dated June 2006. Campsites will be developed distinctively separate from the existing RV Sites and will be subject to an off-site service fee and an annual Campsite Fee equal to the RV Site Fee.

Whitford Construction Service Agreement - Council received and filed an Administrative Report concerning the Whitford Construction Service agreement, paving the way for the development of the Spurce Grove Park as previously approved.

Subdivision Applications - Council endorsed a subdivision application on 2nd Crescent N that will subdivide a large lot into two and one on Timmerman Place that will adjust the location of the property boundary separating two lots.

**Discretionary Use Application** - Council granted discretionary use for the development of a aircraft hangar on Oak Place with conditions including a requirement the development of a primary dwelling within 2 years.

#### **JULY**

Online Service Request Software Enhancements - Improvements to the online Service Request Software will be made in August. User access will not change but the public will notice an enhanced follow up process.

Gravel Crushing - Work has been tendered, and crushing will start at the Village gravel pit along Main Street in August.

Bayview Pedestrian Crossing and Trail Extension - RVCL has received funding from the SGI Safety Grant to construct a signalized pedestrian crossing at the intersection of Bay View Drive and Highway 265 and to extend the pedestrian trail to connect the Fun Run Trail with the West Side Trail along the service road.

Simon Lehne Trail Extension – An application for Federal Active Transportation Funding to construct a pedestrian trail along Simon Lehne from Main Street to Ford Road is currently under consideration. Work could commence this fall if approval is received.

Community Hall Rehabilitation - Project is nearing completion with work remaining to finish the installation of the mechanical exhaust systems and exterior finishes and landscaping.



Nobles Point Boat Launch - Council directed Administration to send a letter to the Ministry of Environment concerning long term certainty and responsible management of the Nobles Point facility. The facility is located on provincial lands within the municipality, and we are seeking Ministry consideration of previous proposals from the Village to operate the site as a permanent public municipal recreational area.

Satellite Fire Station - Council approved a fundraising initiative for the construction of a future satellite Fire Station near the Telwin Subdivision to service neighbourhoods along Hwy 265 outside the 8 km radius of the Main Fire Hall. Any funds donated to the Emergency Services Department in excess of the cost associated with the wildfire response will be directed towards the future development of the Satellite Fire Station. A benefit concert put on by Donny Parenteau will take place on July 25th at the Candle Lake Hall and a Brenda Lee Cottrell concert will take place in Saskatoon at the Broadway Theatre on October 8th with proceeds from both designated to this cause.

Quick Fire Response Vehicle - Council approved the reallocation of capital funding in the 2025 Emergency Services Capital Budget to acquire a 1-ton truck to serve as a platform for a Fire Suppression Unit (FSU) acquired during the wildfire response. This will be used to provide additional fire suppression capabilities within the Village and allow the department to respond quicker to a fire call.

Community - Driven Plan for Health and Wellness - Council received the "What We Know Presentation" from the RVCL Health Services Board and adopted the Community Driven Plan prepared for Saskatchewan Health Quality Council. The success of the plan will depend on the active involvement of the community to explore ways to secure funding for coordinator roles, implement structured volunteer support systems, and foster continuous community engagement.

Candle Lake Curling Club Grant Application - Council endorsed an application from the Club for a grant from Farm Credit Canada Agri Spirit Fund to construct an addition to the curling rink.

Shoe Fire Emergency Response Recognition - Council directed the CAO to execute a compensation program in recognition of the contribution of members of the Emergency Operations Centre EOC and staff of the RVCL during the Shoe Fire Emergency response.
