



## RESORT VILLAGE OF CANDLE LAKE

### Bylaw #04-2026

#### A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF CANDLE LAKE TO ESTABLISH A LAGOON WASTE MANAGEMENT RATE

That Council of the Resort Village of Candle Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw will be known as the “Lagoon Waste Management Rate”
2. The following rates shall be applied for use of the lagoons for the purpose of lagoon waste management within the municipal boundaries of the Resort Village of Candle Lake:
  1. Sewage Utility Rate – From properties Outside the Resort Village without a current Sewage Service Contract with the Resort Village:
    - a) A Commercial Hauler granted approval to transport sewage to the Sewage Collection System from properties situated outside of the Resort Village shall remit to the Resort Village a rate of \$0.045 per gallon. This rate shall apply to all Commercial Haulers based on the monthly records submitted.
    - b) All invoices are due and payable thirty (30) days from the date of issue.
    - c) Accounts for services that are outstanding, and which remain unpaid within thirty (30) days from the date of issue are subject to a penalty for late payment of 1.8% monthly and may result in the Resort Village revoking the Commercial Hauler access to the Sewage Collection System until the amount owing is paid in full.
  2. Sewage Utility Rate – For Taxable Properties with Improvements in the Resort Village or from outside the Resort Village of Candle Lake with a current Sewage Service Agreement:
    - a) For all improved properties in the Resort Village, an annual rate of \$100.00 per property shall be levied.
    - b) For all properties outside of the Resort Village of Candle Lake with a current Service Contract with the Resort Village, an annual rate of \$100.00 per Building Unit with a sewage collection system and \$50.00 per campsite or RV site shall be levied. Building Unit is defined as any building or part of a building that has an independent entrance to outside.
    - c) All levies are due and payable August 31<sup>st</sup> of the year issued. Penalty for late payment is 1.8% monthly.

The rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee.

THAT Bylaw 06-2025 is hereby repealed.
