ATV

Bylaw No 13-2021:

AGE:

- Driver must be 16 years of age.
- Have and/or Produce valid Drivers License.

OR.....be 12 years of age. Able to produce proof of completion of (an approved) Highway Traffic Board ATV course, and "Supervised" (in constant communication visually or verbally with person of age with valid Driver's License).

SPEED: **Maximum speed 40 km/hr within RVCL as posted.**

RULES /SAFETY of the Road:

Do not operate ATV on

- Provincial Hwys # 265 & #120
- Ski Trails
- Beach/park areas
- Designated walking paths
- Ditches when wet
- Municipal Reserve, Parks, Green space, Cemetery or Playgrounds
- SEE BYLAW 13 OF 2021 FOR MORE DETAILS

DO:

- Drive on municipal roadways following flow of traffic.
- Yield the right-of-way to all vehicles and pedestrians at all intersections.
- **Maximum speed 40 km/hr on RVCL roadways**
- Refrain from stunt driving or unreasonable noise.

REGISTER:

- Any **ATV & Dirt Bike** owners who intends to drive his/her ATV or Dirt Bike within the RVCL **must** obtain a permit and attach the (provided) plate to the ATV or Dirt Bike where visible on the back of said ATV or Dirt Bike.

* Attend the Village office to register you ATV or Dirt Bike
