BYLAW 04 of 2018

A Bylaw of The Resort Village of Candle Lake to amend Bylaw 07 of 2012 – A
Bylaw to Regulate the Operation of All Terrain Vehicles

The Council of the Resort Village of Candle Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That Bylaw 07 of 2012 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Adding to Definitions: 3. i) Permit – a numbered placard issued by the municipality to identify all terrain vehicles operation within municipal boundaries.
2. Adding to Rules of Operation: 9. h) Every all terrain vehicle operating within the municipal boundaries shall display the permit purchased from the municipal office in a visible space at the rear of the ATV. The application is attached hereto as ``Schedule 1`` to this bylaw.
3. Addition of Section 11.1 which reads as follows:

VEHICLE IMPOUNDMENT

11.1

(1) A bylaw officer may seize any all terrain vehicle that he/she, on reasonable and probable grounds believes is:

- a) being operated in contravention of regulations of this bylaw and
- b) the operation of the all terrain vehicle constitutes or may constitute a hazard to persons who are or might reasonably be expected to be in the area and may retain it in his possession or store in a suitable place.

(2) The owner of an all terrain vehicle that has been seized pursuant to subsection (1) or his agent may obtain the release of the vehicle if he:

- a) obtains the written consent of the municipality to do so

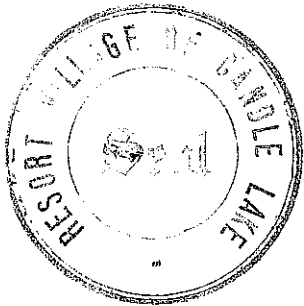
b) pays the expenses of the seizure and the retention or storage of the all terrain vehicle.
