Bylaw 17 of 2021

A BYLAW TO CONTROL, REGULATE AND PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF TAXICABS AND TAXICAB DRIVERS

THE COUNCIL of the Resort Village of Candle Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

PART I: INTERPRETATION

SHORT TITLE

1. This Bylaw may be cited as “The Taxi Bylaw”.

DEFINITIONS

2. In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires, the expressions:

Administrator means the Administrator of the Resort Village of Candle Lake as defined in The Municipalities Act for the Province of Saskatchewan.

Permit means the permit issued by the Resort Village of Candle Lake for the operation of a taxicab in accordance with this bylaw.

Permit Inspector shall mean the municipal enforcement officer(s) appointed by the Resort Village who shall be directly responsible for the supervision and control of the issue of taxicab permits; and, in the absence of such appointment, shall mean the Administrator.

Resort Village means the Resort Village of Candle Lake (RVCL)

Taxicab means a vehicle, including Uber, which is employed in the conveyance of passengers for hire, including delivery service, except:

- I. Ambulance;
- II. Bus;
- III. A vehicle especially designed to transport, for hire, persons confined to a

wheelchair along with the said wheelchairs, and which does not carry for compensation any other type of passenger;

- IV. A vehicle known as a “U-Drive” vehicle which is rented without a driver;
- V. A vehicle approved for use as a transport depot limousine by the License Inspector;
- VI. Vehicles restrictively licensed by a valid and subsisting Operating Authority Certificate issued pursuant to *The Motor Carrier Act, S.S. 1986, C. M 21.1* and/or *The Motor Vehicles Transportation Act (Canada, 1954)*, to provide specialized non-emergency transportation for hire for medically stable passengers, and for medical purposes.

Uber means a transportation company with an app that allows passengers to hail a ride and drivers to charge fares. More specifically, Uber is a ridesharing company that hires independent contractors as drivers.

PART II: REGULATIONS

- 3. (a) A permit to Operate a Taxicab in the Resort Village of Candle Lake shall be taken out by every person who owns or keeps for hire or profit a taxi and taxicabs as per Schedule “B”, and shall pay therefore the annual Resort Village permit fee provided for in Schedule “A” to this bylaw.
 - (b) Taxicab permits shall not be transferrable, nor leased or assigned in any manner, except with the written permission of the Council of the Resort Village; and, if permission has not been given, the taxicab and Uber licenses on expiration shall be returned to the Resort Village for disposition.
 - (c) An issued permit must be posted in the taxicab at all times and displayed on the ride side rear window of the taxicab.
 - (d) There will be no limit on the number of permits issued for the operation of a taxicab in a calendar year.
 - (e) Every person who own or keeps the hire or profit of a taxicab or taxicabs shall produce to the Permit Inspector or their designate:
 - i) within 24 hours of a demand by the Permit Inspector adequate proof that each vehicle being operated as a taxicab is duly licensed under *The Vehicles Administration Act* for the Province of Saskatchewan and the regulations

thereunder;

ii) within 24 hours upon demand of the Permit Inspector or their designate, a valid and current safety inspection obtained from a taxicab inspection station certified by SGI in respect of the taxicab or taxicabs.

iii) In the event that any person who owns or keeps for hire or provide a taxicab or taxicabs shall fail to produce any evidence required by section 3(e)(i) or (ii) above, then the taxicab permit issued by the Resort Village shall be immediately revoked whereupon the owner shall immediately remove the taxicab permit and return the same to the Permit Inspector or their designate.

(f) Every operator of a taxicab business is required to obtain and maintain an annual Business License with the Resort Village of Candle Lake.

(g) Every taxicab permit, unless the same is forfeited sooner, shall be for the period of one year extending from January 1 in the current year and shall expire on the 31st day of December in the same year.

(h) Any person who violates any of the provision of this bylaw shall be subject to prosecution and the penalties provide for in the General Penalties Bylaw of the Resort Village of Candle Lake.

4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on, from and after the final passing thereof.
