FIREWORKS

Purpose:
To regulate the sale and management of fireworks and increase public safety.

Rules:
- LOW hazard fireworks can be sold to or set off by any person 18 years or older.

- NO PERSON shall set off fireworks between the hours of 11pm and 8 am daily Unless they have obtained prior written approval from the Candle Lk Fire Dept or Administrator.

- HIGH hazard /Public Firework display requires a Firework permit from the Candle Lake Fire Dept. **NO PERSON** shall set off fireworks in a manner that would create danger, nuisance, annoy, disturb, injure or otherwise distract from the health and safety of another person and/or property. **See Explosives Regulations (C.R.C., c. 599)**

- ATV Safety: During dry conditions, ATV's can cause fires to ignite. Be cautious to keep exhaust systems free of debris and avoid areas with long grass in dry conditions.

OPEN FIRES

All open fires shall always be supervised.

Burning of refuse, rubbish, or any material that will generate black smoke or offensive odors is prohibited.

Burning for land clearing purposes is prohibited.

No person shall light, ignite, start or cause to be lighted a fire of any kind whatsoever in the open air if it is unsafe to do so.

Where requested by the Fire Chief or a Peace Officer, a person shall extinguish an open-air fire. Persons not complying with the request are subject to penalty.

Chimney, Portable Fire

Pits & BBQ's:

Rules:
-Use in a reasonable safe manner.

-Maintain a sufficient distance away from all combustible materials and buildings.

-comply with all Federal and Provincial regulations regarding the use and storage of propane cylinders.
